1. Provide Al-Anon information to local public and professionals.
2. Maintain a phone number for Al-Anon information services.
3. Develop and maintain a list of members to answer information services phone calls.
4. Develop and maintain training for members willing to answer information services phone calls (under development!)
5. Maintain an accurate meeting list for meetings in their area.
6. Maintain the website with updated information including phone number, and meeting list.
7. Develop a list of members willing to speak to professionals and at events.
8. Create and publish meeting and financial records.
9. Provide literature as appropriate (AFA, meeting schedules, etc. ) to professional, groups, health fairs, etc.
